UK Scope & Eligibility

Innovate UK is a member country of the Eureka network, the world's largest public network for international cooperation in R&D&I, present in 47 countries.

Innovate UK is an active member of Eureka, and we see participation in the funding streams, that Eureka provides, as a valuable tool to help UK organisations scale up their approach to international collaboration.

The theme of Global Opportunities is one of our key themes set out in our Plan for Action and is all about inspiring, involving and investing. Our plan also ties in with the UK's Innovation Strategy as set out by the Department of Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy.

UK Scope & Eligibility



Your project

- UK applicants can apply for total grant of up to £750,000 for each project partner.
- All types of UK registered organisations can apply for funding.
- Expected duration 12 – 36 months
- Your project must be collaborative.

Funding

There is no funding for the Autumn 2025 Call

For industrial research projects, you could get funding for your eligible project costs of:

- up to 70% if you are a small enterprise
- up to 60% if you are a medium enterprise
- up to 50% if you are a large enterprise
- UK registered [research organisations](#) in your consortium can share up to 30% of the UK industry eligible project costs. If your consortium contains more than one UK research organisation, this maximum will be shared between them.

Of that 30% you could get funding for your eligible project costs of up to:

80% of full economic costs (FEC) if you are a Je-s registered institution such as an academic



UK Scope & Eligibility

Other UK criteria:

- Funding will only be given to ROs if there is a UK business entity in the consortium. ROs may still participate where no UK business entity is a partner, however you will need to self-fund
- In the event of having more projects than budget, Innovate UK will hold a consensus meeting to select projects that fit national and Innovate UK priorities.
- UK partners will not be required to complete an additional evaluated national application, however there will be an application that will capture your details and costs. This will happen post labelling decision of your project.
- Ensure you read the guidance on the ITEA [website](#), to the call process, as there is criteria which is set by ITEA in addition to national criteria
- If you have questions relating to your partner countries, then get them to contact their National Funding Body (NFB)
